How to Become a Registered User of MUP Library

- MUP students, graduates and employees are entitled to use all library services after the first registration by presenting a chip card (ISIC, access card), which then serves as their reader's card.
- The general public can also use the library services.

Online Library Catalogue

- The catalogue is accessible via the MUP website https://tritius.mup.cz
- In the catalogue you find all books, journals, final dissertations and other publications held by the university.



- Special collections of the Library of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), donations from the Council of Europe, and the private collections of Professor Jiří Hájek are also available in the library.
- Basic and advanced search options are supported in the catalogue (search by author, by title, by keywords or a combination of the categories).

Ordering and Reservation of Documents

- Via the online catalogue.
- Reservation of documents that are checked out. (Please note it's not possible to reserve a document that is available for on-site borrowing only.).
- Reservation of books that are checked out.
- Scheduling access to books from the library stock and final dissertations written by MUP students for a given date at the earliest 10 working days and at the latest one working day before the loan is to take place ("Pickup date" field). Orders for the next working day may only be placed from Monday to Saturday by 4 p.m.

Library Account

Information at a glance including:

- when your books are due,
- what books you have reserved or ordered,
- · history of your library transactions.

With the use of your library account, you can:

- · extend the loan periods of your books,
- cancel outstanding reservations or orders,
- access full-text databases, such as EBSCO, JSTOR and E-Books Cambridge Core, from anywhere.

Extension of the Loan Period

- Via your Library account, email, telephone, or in person.
- You can extend the loan period only prior to its expiration.
- Only documents that are not reserved by other library members can be extended.
